### PARTICIPATION

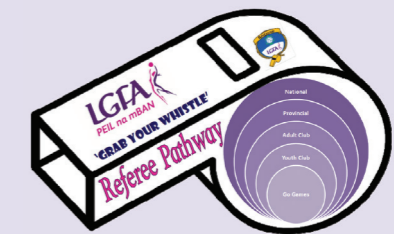
- Promote Gaelic4Girls, Gaelic4Mothers&Others and GAA Cúl Camps initiatives
